Turn off the faucet or shower when you don't need it – such as while brushing your teeth or soaping up.



Challenge yourself and others to **shorten showers by one minute or more**. Your household could save more than a thousand gallons a year!



Make sure your toilet stopper seals after every flush. Check the tank if your toilet continues to run after flushing, the toilet stopper may not be properly sealed.



Leaks mean water lost – **report leaks to maintenance immediately**. Even small leaks can add up to thousands of gallons of water (and dollars) wasted each month.
