Training Suite Course Descriptions

Core Trainings

Building Analyst—October 13-17, 2008

Training covers the fundamentals of building science, shell types and building components, thermal pressure boundaries, air sealing, blower door technology and testing, building calculations, airflow and ventilation, combustion science and safety, cost effectiveness of energy measures, and health and safety.

Envelope Specialty—October 28–30, 2008

Training covers the house-as-a-whole system approach to building science, the science of moisture, psychrometrics, thermal and pressure boundaries, air sealing, blower door technology and testing, series leakage, Building Airflow Standards (BAS), ventilation systems, combustion safety, gas leak detection, health and safety, and complete house evaluation.

Heating Specialty—November 11–13, 2008

Training covers combustion appliance fundamentals, distribution and fuel types, as well as health and safety issues related to newer and aging equipment. The course will also address in-field combustion efficiency and carbon monoxide testing on existing systems, and duct and pressure diagnostics to identify duct system leakage and problems.

Support Trainings

Home Performance with ENERGY STAR Sales and Marketing— (TBA)

Training focuses on in-office and in-home strategies for successful selling of Home Performance with ENERGY STAR; using diagnostic tools and processes in a consultative selling manner; and techniques for communicating benefits, problems, countering of objections, closing deals, and motivating homeowners into action.

HomeCheck Software Training—(TBA)

Training shows you how to use this in-depth technical and financial analysis tool to quickly calculate potential energy savings to the customer and provide professional assessment reports.

Recommended Additional Training

Duct Sealing—November 19-20, 2008

Training covers the basics of duct leakage, measuring duct leakage, combustion appliance zone testing, duct sealing, Oregon State tax credit duct testing and sealing standards and procedures, and CAZ testing standards and procedures. Requires three technical field evaluations.

Building Performance Institute (BPI) Certification Requirements

Training Suites A, B, and C consist of classroom and field sessions. Written and field exams must be passed to complete certification. Building Analyst requires a 100-question written exam; in addition, a 50-question exam is required for Envelope and Heating Training. Three field mentoring sessions with a Home Performance Account Manager offers technical support, and occur prior to field exams.
