

Building Efficiency: **Burgerville**



Sprayers help Burgerville soak up savings

Dishwashing can put restaurant energy, water and sewer bills in hot water if equipment is inefficient. But more and more restaurants—including hometown favorite Burgerville—are keeping their dollars from going down the drain by installing high performance pre-rinse sprayers with help from Energy Trust of Oregon.

Through a special offer for Oregon restaurants and food-service establishments, Energy Trust installed the efficient sprayers in 19 Burgerville restaurants at no cost. The sprayers, which use just 1.6 gallons of water per minute, are expected to cut annual energy and water costs by \$400 per restaurant. For Burgerville, that adds up to tasty savings of \$7,600 every year.

Strategies

Burgerville took advantage of a limited time offer from Energy Trust to receive free high performance pre-rinse sprayers. The sprayers were installed by a licensed journeyman plumber in 19 Portland-area Burgerville restaurants.

Project Benefits

- Lower operating costs—energy, water and sewer
- Reduced environmental impacts
- Estimated annual savings of 3,168 therms and 4,862 kilowatt hours

Financial Analysis

Energy Trust installed the sprayers at no cost to Burgerville.

- \$1292 value of sprayers (19 at \$68 each)
- \$7,600 estimated annual energy and water cost savings
