### **Energy Trust to re-bid contracts for Production Efficiency Program Delivery Contractors**

PORTLAND, Ore. — May 2, 2008 – Energy Trust plans to re-bid the contracts for Program Delivery Contractors (PDCs) for the Business Energy Solutions—Production Efficiency program serving medium and large industrial facilities. The winning bidders will negotiate with Energy Trust for a three-year contract with an optional one-year extension. Energy Trust has set a preliminary schedule to release the Request for Proposal on May 12; proposals are due to Energy Trust on June 20.

Respondents are asked to submit their proposals for territory assignments either by geography, market segment focus or a combination of the two, based on their particular expertise. Up to six PDCs will be selected to serve all the industrial facilities in Portland General Electric and Pacific Power service territories within Oregon. The estimated combined contract value for all selected PDCs in 2009 is \$2.2 million, with the total program budget for the first year estimated at \$11 million.
