Incentives for Washington customers of NW Natural. Insulation incentives are available for standalone single-family or manufactured homes. All work must comply with Home Retrofit Specification Manual.		
Attic Insulation	If R-11 or less, then insulate to R-38. Manufactured homes are not eligible for this incentive.	\$0.25 per square foot.
Wall Insulation	If R-4 or less, then insulate to R-11 or fill cavity. All heated exterior wall surfaces must be insulated. Manufactured homes are not eligible for this incentive.	\$0.30 per square foot.
Floor Insulation	If R-0, insulate to R-30, or fill cavity	\$0.30 per square foot.
Knee Wall Insulation	If R-4 or less, insulate 2x4 cavities to R-15 or insulate 2x6 cavities to R-21. Cover attic side of wall with vapor permeable air barrier. Manufactured homes are not eligible for this incentive.	\$0.30 per square foot.
Rim Joist Insulation	If R-4 or less, insulate to R-15. Manufactured homes are not eligible for this incentive.	\$0.30 per square foot.

Windows	U-Value 0.27 or less.	\$4.00 per square foot installed

Gas Furnace	95% or greater AFUE. Must be home's primary heat source. Not eligible for gas furnaces used as backup for high- efficiency heat pumps, also known as hybrid systems. A CO monitor is required on every floor with a bedroom.	\$200
Gas Fireplace	75% or greater FE. Visit www.energytrust.org/fireplace for a list of eligible models. Unit must be equipped with electronic pilot light ignition and be vented to outside with sealed combustion. A CO monitor is required on every floor with a bedroom.	\$250
	70% - 74.9% FE. Visit www.energytrust.org/fireplace for a list of eligible models. Unit must be equipped with electronic pilot light ignition and be vented to outside with sealed combustion. A CO monitor is required on every floor with a bedroom.	\$150
Smart Thermostat	Home must be primarily heated by a gas forced-air furnace. Thermostat must be connected to the internet through a Wi-Fi network and configured with the home's location. Visit http://www.energytrust.org/thermostat for eligible models. One incentive per residence.	\$50
