To maintain trade ally status, trade allies are expected to:

- Enroll a minimum number of projects per year
- Hold required licenses, including an Oregon Construction Contractors Board or Washington contractors license (if applicable)
- Maintain required insurance coverage and necessary certifications (if applicable)
- Provide excellent customer service, including prompt resolution of customer concerns
- Make participation easy by helping customers complete incentive applications and state and federal tax credit paperwork (if applicable), and submit all required customer incentive applications and forms in full
