



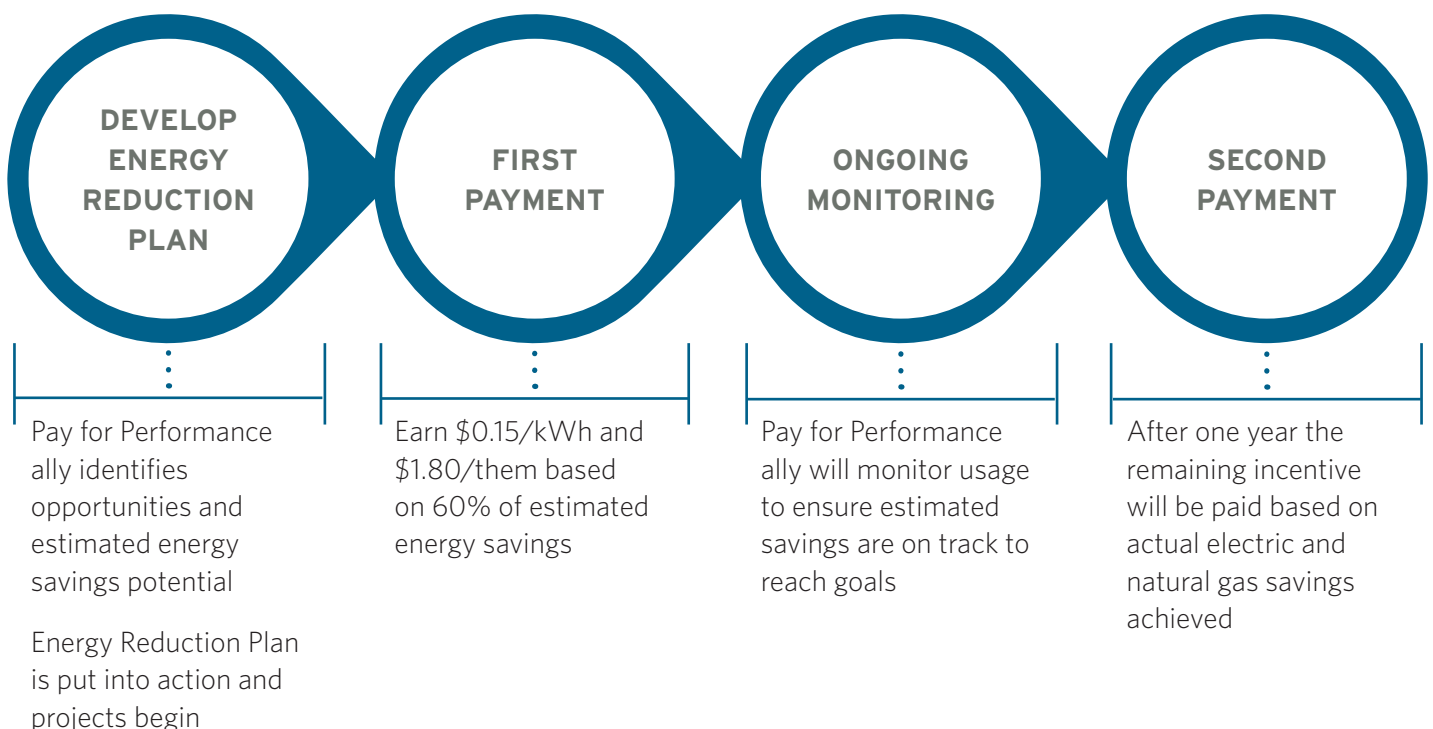

## Optimize your building performance now

You are an ideal Pay for Performance candidate if you are willing to commit to energy management practices that will help maintain optimal energy performance of the building.

### Eligibility

Incentives for energy improvements are available to commercial, municipal, educational and institutional customers served by Energy Trust of Oregon. To qualify for Pay for Performance, you must:

- Be improving an existing structure in Oregon
- Be served by a participating utility
- Have at least 12 months of energy usage data
- Work with a Pay for Performance ally
- Have total energy savings of 5% or more in project estimate

## Measurable Results

Pay for Performance leads to real world savings validated at the meter. Pay for Performance gives property owners and managers a tool to effectively manage energy-saving actions that will help participating companies reduce energy use and reach associated environmental, social and governance (ESG) goals.
