OREGON BUSINESS CUSTOMERS

Tankless water heaters deliver on-demand, continuous hot water flow while avoiding the standby losses associated with standard tank water heaters. This can save energy and money, compared to water heaters with storage tanks.

Energy Trust of Oregon is now offering a \$300 incentive for the installation of new or replacement gas-condensing tankless water heaters < 200 kBtu/h. The incentive covers all qualified units up to 199,999 Btu/h for eligible Oregon business customers on qualifying rate schedules of NW Natural, Cascade Natural Gas and Avista.

Cash incentives are available for tankless water heaters in:

- Coin-operated laundries
- Restaurants and cafeterias, including those inside other buildings such as colleges, offices or hotels
- Grocery stores with foodservice areas
- Gyms/fitness and aquatic centers, including those inside other buildings such as hotels and K-12 schools, colleges and universities
- K-12 schools
