They can save money now and save energy and money for years to come by making energy-efficiency upgrades to their foodservice equipment.

This gas equipment bonus is available for eligible Oregon customers on qualifying rate schedules of NW Natural, Cascade Natural Gas and Avista. No pre-approval is needed. Equipment must be installed between October 18, 2017 and December 31, 2017. All required documentation must be submitted to Energy Trust according to the time frames in your incentive application and no later than December 31, 2017. Installation dates and applications submitted after these required dates may be eligible for the standard incentive but will not be eligible for the bonus incentive. A post-installation verification may apply. Incentives are subject to funding availability and may change. The total amount provided by Energy Trust for qualifying foodservice equipment (base plus bonus incentives) will not exceed the documented cost of the equipment. Additional requirements may apply.
