



Energy Trust of Oregon, Inc. ("Energy Trust") is seeking organizations to participate in its **Community Partner Funding** program (the "Program") as outlined in this Agreement. Read this Agreement and then complete the information required in the signature box on page three. **Return the completed and signed Agreement to Energy Trust at the address at the bottom of this form.**

To participate, an organization must complete all sections of this participation agreement *Form 371CPF: Participation Agreement - Participating Organization – Community Partner Funding* (the "Agreement"). Upon submission of a complete and signed Agreement, Energy Trust will determine whether to approve or deny participation. Upon receiving a signed copy of this Agreement with Energy Trust approval, the organization will be eligible to receive training to become a "Participating Organization." Upon completion of required training, the organization becomes a Participating Organization eligible to participate in the Program. Each Participating Organization will receive *Form Pl320CPF: Community Partner Program Information (PI) Sheet* that will confirm available measures and funding amounts.

Program Information

Energy Trust funding is offered for eligible projects completed by a Participating Organization that contain qualifying energy-saving devices and services. Funding is provided to a Participating Organization that managed the completion of the eligible project. The Participating Organization submits to Energy Trust a signed *Form 300CPF: Participating Organization Authorization Form*, copy of installer(s) invoices, and required project documentation showing the total amount paid by the Participating Organization to install the given energy upgrades. Required project documentation will vary depending on which energy-savings upgrades the Participating Organization is requesting reimbursement. Participating Organization will refer to the PI Sheet for documentation requirements and guidelines. Upon receiving this information, Energy Trust pays the funding amount to the Participating Organization. Only a Participating Organization may offer the funding as outlined below.

PARTICIPATING ORGANIZATION OBLIGATIONS: Participating Organization bears responsibility for determining each customer's eligibility for Community Partner Funding, based upon the Community Partner Funding PI sheet. Community Partner Funding is available to detached single-family and manufactured home customers who are (i) Oregon residential electric service customers of Portland General Electric or Pacific Power and (ii) Oregon residential natural gas service customers of NW Natural, Cascade Natural Gas or Avista. Community Partner Funding is available to detached single-family, manufactured home, and small multifamily (plexes up to four and side-by-side properties) who are (iii) Washington residential natural gas service customers of NW Natural.

- 1. Participating Organization agrees to verify project installations by including contractors' invoices after installation of a qualifying energy upgrade.
- 2. Participating Organization must not employ as a contractor any firm that has been suspended or terminated from any Energy Trust program, except those suspended or terminated due to low participation. Contractors must comply with all applicable laws and certify that they have and shall maintain all appropriate licenses, registrations, and certifications for the work it performs, including, but not limited to, Construction Contractors Board (CCB) requirements and shall be solely responsible for its noncompliance with said laws, licenses, registrations and certifications.
- 3. Participating Organization shall submit a completed funding application, signed Form 300CPF: Participating Organization Community Partner Funding Authorization and an invoice copy for each installation for which Energy Trust funding reimbursement is sought. Participating Organization may choose whether to complete the optional Customer & Project Information Application on Form300CPF, or submit supporting documentation verifying the same information to establish upgrade eligibility
- 4. If Participating Organization is a community action agency that administers utility ratepayer funding, then it shall submit energy audit documentation in order to receive reimbursement for qualifying sites for energy upgrades and complete quality assurance records which document all completed energy upgrades at the site, even for improvements that do not receive Energy Trust funding.
- 5. If Participating Organization does not receive utility rate payer funding, then it shall submit required project and customer information as defined by the program. Participating Organization will use program provided audit tools, and share data collected with the program. Work with a program representative to ensure energy audit incentive requirements are met.

Additional Funding Sources

Participating Organizations providing weatherization, HVAC upgrades or in-home repair services in combination with Energy Trust funding for income-eligible customers agrees to disclose all rate payer and non-ratepayer funding that will be used on projects funded by Energy Trust.

RATEPAYER FUNDING: Participating Organization cannot apply ratepayer funding towards projects funded by Energy Trust unless approved to do so by the Oregon Public Utilities Commission prior to the signing of this agreement. If ratepayer funding is selected below, then Participating Organization must provide unique Job IDs as reported to the Oregon Housing and Community Services for each project on *Form 300CPF: Participating Organization Community Partner Funding Authorization.*

If utility ratepayer funding is not disclosed on this form, Participating Organization cannot use utility ratepayer funding to cover any associated costs for projects funded by Energy Trust.



Additional Terms and Conditions for Participation as a Participating Organization

SERVICE STANDARD: Participating Organization will exercise a high level of customer service and perform Program services at all times in a professional manner. Additionally, Participating Organization will cooperate and collaborate closely with Energy Trust.

PROGRAM MARKETING: Participating Organization may use Energy Trust's logo on marketing or advertising materials only with prior approval from Energy Trust.

NON-DISCLOSURE AGREEMENT: Participating Organization may receive customer information from Energy Trust. Any information received from Energy Trust that is not regarded as public knowledge is to be treated by Participating Organization as private and confidential. No customer information may be shared with anyone except as necessary with contractors to assess, bid on, and complete measures for Customers.

TIMELINESS: Participating Organization will respond to Energy Trust or Customer requests within three (3) business days.

JOB COMPLETION TIMELINES: Participating Organization agrees to submit application materials to the Program within sixty (60) business days of installation completion unless additional time is authorized in writing by Energy Trust.

WARRANTY: Participating Organization must provide the Customer with a written warranty on labor and materials for a minimum of one year from the date the service is completed (this excludes caulk or mastic work). Installed equipment must carry manufacturer's warranty, including any applicable extended warranty coverage.

QUALITY ASSURANCE (QA) VERIFICATIONS: QA verifications are assessments of work performed under the Program for compliance with the current Home Retrofit Specifications Manual, the PTCS specifications and this Agreement. Energy Trust may request Participating Organization's findings from QA verifications completed. The Participating Organization will not hold Energy Trust responsible in any lawsuit arising from work completed under the Program.

SUSPENSION AND TERMINATION: Participating Organization acknowledges and agrees that Energy Trust may suspend and/or end Participating Organization's eligibility for participation in Program activities at any time for revisions to the Program, for violation of this Agreement or for any other reason, in its sole discretion. Participating Organization will be promptly notified in writing of such suspension or termination. In particular but without limitation, Energy Trust will immediately terminate this Agreement if Participating Organization is found to have falsified paperwork. Participating Organization may terminate this Agreement at any time.
