APPLICATION: This *Form 620RB* must be filled out completely, truthfully, and accurately. Trade Allies are advised to retain a copy of this application and any accompanying documentation submitted to Energy Trust. under this program. Energy Trust will not be responsible for lost documentation pertaining to this application request.

ELIGIBILITY: The First Time Rural Builder Incentive is available to builders and developers planning housing developments to be sited in the Oregon electric service territories of Portland General Electric, Pacific Power, or the Oregon gas service territories of NW Natural, Cascade Natural Gas or Avista. Eligible candidates must be an approved trade ally with the EPS New Construction program.

PAYMENT: The First Time Rural Builder Incentive will be paid to the *builder* after builder receives notification of approval as an EPS New Construction Trade Ally, on submission of the completed *Form 620RB*. Please allow up to 60 days for receipt of payment after verification and all paperwork is received. Builders may only receive this incentive one time.

RURAL: To qualify as rural, homes must be sited within Energy Trust <u>Regions</u> 1, 2, 5, 7, 9, 10, or 11, excluding homes within the city limits of Corvallis, Eugene, Springfield, and Hood River. Upon request, program staff can make exceptions to qualify additional areas as rural.

INFORMATION RELEASE: The Builder Company understands and agrees that Energy Trust and/or its representatives may include a description of this application, including the Builder Company Authorized Representative name, the Builder Company name, and tax documentation required by the Energy Trust Board of Directors, the Oregon Public Utility Commission, Oregon Department of Energy, Oregon Housing & Community Services, the Oregon Legislature, funding utilities, and/or other governmental agencies. Energy Trust will treat all other information gathered in evaluations as confidential and report it only in the aggregate.
