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Terms and Conditions:

1. APPLICATION. This *Form 100E* must be filled out completely, truthfully and accurately. If Participant, as named above in this application, is submitting an accompanying Multiple Sites Addendum to enroll more than one site under this application, such Multiple Sites Addendum is hereby fully incorporated into this Custom Energy Assessment Request by this reference. Funds for Energy Trust's Existing Buildings program (Program) are limited and subject to availability. Program details, including incentives and Program-provided technical assistance, are subject to change without prior notice. The Program Management Contractor (PMC) provides services for the Program on behalf of Energy Trust. Neither Energy Trust nor the PMC will be responsible for any lost documentation pertaining to this application.

2. TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE. Participant may qualify to receive a technical analysis study or other technical assistance (Technical Assistance) from the Program to help identify potential energy efficiency measures at your building(s). If so, a representative will contact you to discuss scheduling. If Participant accepts any Technical Assistance, then Participant agrees to inform the Program representative of applicable job site regulations for the building, if any, prior to the site visit. Energy Trust reserves the right to revise or terminate the Program-provided Technical Assistance at any time. Determination of eligibility for Technical Assistance rests solely with Energy Trust. Not all applicants will qualify.

3. ENERGY EFFICIENCY MEASURES. After Energy Trust's review of a technical analysis study, Energy Trust will notify Participant if any of the identified measures meet cost-effectiveness and other Program requirements. If so, additional Energy Trust incentives may be available to help Participant offset the costs of implementing certain energy saving projects. If measures are identified that meet Program criteria and Participant does not choose to implement any of them, it may affect eligibility for future Technical Assistance under the Program. Any decision by Energy Trust to fund a technical analysis study or other Technical Assistance for Participant hereunder does not in any way imply a commitment by Energy Trust to provide any funding for any further Technical Assistance or any related or unrelated energy project(s).

4. ACCESS AND EVALUATION. For the purpose of conducting Technical Assistance, Participant agrees to provide Energy Trust's Program representative(s) with access to the property identified as the site address herein and represents that it has or will obtain any and all necessary consents and is in compliance with applicable laws and regulations. Reviews and evaluations of the project work before, during and after measures installation are a critical part of Energy Trust's verification and evaluation process for energy savings and incentive calculations. Participant agrees to provide Energy Trust and its representatives with (i) reasonable access to the project site(s) to review and evaluate the project, and (ii) requested technical and other project documentation related to the measures. If Participant is a multifamily property owner/representative providing Energy Trust with in-unit access to perform any Technical Assistance (ex. a walk-through survey), Participant will (i) make authorized Participant personnel available to be present ad accompany Program representatives, (ii) comply with all laws and stipulations in tenant leases regarding Participant notification and access to tenant units; and (iii) provide Program representatives with advance notice of any and all units where tenants have not agreed to allow Energy Trust access and ensure that Program representative(s) are prohibited from accessing such units.

5. NO ENDORSEMENT. Energy Trust does not endorse any particular manufacturer, contractor or product in promoting the Program. ENERGY TRUST'S LIABILITY IS LIMITED TO THE AMOUNT OF ANY INCENTIVE FUNDS OWED FOR PARTICIPANT'S TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE AS AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS AGREEMENT. IN NO EVENT WILL ENERGY TRUST OR ITS REPRESENTATIVES BE LIABLE PURSUANT TO THIS AGREEMENT TO PARTICIPANT OR ANY THIRD PARTY FOR ANY OTHER DAMAGES, WHETHER CHARACTERIZED AS GENERAL, SPECIAL, DIRECT, INDIRECT, PUNITIVE, CONSEQUENTIAL, OR OTHERWISE. Additionally, Participant hereby indemnifies Energy Trust from and against any and all losses, liabilities, damages, claims, suits, actions, judgments, assessments, costs and expenses, including but not limited to any interest, penalties, or attorneys' fees arising out of or connected with this agreement; provided, however, that as applied to any State of Oregon agency or political subdivision thereof, this indemnification obligation applies to the extent permitted by the Oregon Tort Claims Act, ORS 30.260 through 30.300 and Article XI, Section 7 of the Oregon Constitution. Energy Trust is not responsible for any tax liability which may be imposed as a result of payment of any incentives. Energy Trust is not providing tax advice, and any communication by Energy Trust is not intended or written to be used, and cannot be used, for the purpose of avoiding penalties under the Internal Revenue Code.

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8. IMPACTS OF SELF DIRECTION (*PGE or Pacific Power Electric Large Energy User Customers Only*). Energy Trust's energy efficiency programs are funded by amounts charged in rates for cost-effective energy efficiency.
