# The Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde

#### **Location & History**


Grand Ronde is made up of more than 30 tribes and bands from throughout western Oregon, southwest Washington, and northern California.

The Tribe's ceded it's lands (approx. 14 million acres) through 7 different Treaties between 1853 and 1855.

The Tribe's ceded lands and reservation are shown here.

The Tribe was terminated in 1954 by the Federal Government by Western Termination Act and took all land holdings.

The Tribe was restored in 1983.



#### **Project Highlights**

- 24 Units (12 duplexes)
- Each unit is 1,120 Square Feet
- 2 bedrooms and 1 bathroom
- Construction completed in December 2023
- 16 Market Rate Units and 8 Low Income Units
- Each unit has Solar Panels plus backup battery storage
- Rated by Energy Trust of Oregon as Net-Zero residential homes (some of the first in the PNW region)


#### **Key Features of the Homes**

- Raised Heel Trusses
- 2x6 Exterior Framing
- Blown-in Insulation
- Triple Pane Windows
- Sun Tunnels
- High Efficiency Water Heaters, HVAC system and Appliances
- 18 Solar Panels per unit (generates 7kW)





- TERO Hours & Wages:
  - 6021 hours
  - \$265,091 in wages

- New 10,000 square foot building
- Completed in February 2024
- The Clinic is a full-service health center, including medical and dental.
- The facility also includes:
  - Educational classroom
  - Demonstration kitchen
  - Outdoor fish pit



  - 148 Solar Panels (generates 66.6kw)
  - Annual production 76,500 kWh
  - Annual savings \$6,065
  - Offices conditioned with 100% free cooling economizer and VVT controls; Trane Precedent 17 Plus
  - Clinic & Dental spaces conditioned with 4
     RTU with 100% free cooling economizer;
     reheat VAV terminate units; AAON RN
  - Exam spaces (2) designed for future
     Airborne Infection Isolation and (2) for
     infection control; conditioned with 2 RTU
     and capable of 100% outdoor air operation
  - LED fixtures from ETO approved list including: 2x4 troffers, pendants, and task lights
  - Exceeded lighting code by 21%
- TERO Hours & Wages:
  - 2,469 hours
  - \$94,451 in wages




- Floor Plan
